The California Political Reform Act (Proposition 34) places limits on contributions (including loans) to candidates for state office, and imposes certain prohibitions. This request does not seek a contribution in excess of applicable limits or from prohibited sources. An individual, union, political action committee, association, committee, partnership, business or corporation may contribute a maximum of \$5,600 to the committee per election. A registered Small Contributor Committee may contribute a maximum of \$11,100 to the committee per election. Lobbyists registered to lobby the agency of the officeholder or the office for which the candidate is running may not contribute. Contributions of \$100 or more must be returned to the contributor if address, occupation and employer information is not provided. Spouses may each contribute up to the limit.

CALIFORNIA INSURANCE COMMISSIONER JOHN GARAMENDI

Insurance Commissioner John Garamendi has been in public service for more than 30 years. He was elected to a two-year term in the State Assembly in 1974 and to four terms in the State Senate in 1976, 1980, 1984, and 1988. He was California's first elected Insurance Commissioner from 1991 through 1995. In 1995, Mr. Garamendi was appointed by President Clinton as the Deputy Secretary of the U.S. Department of the Interior and held that office until 1998. In 2002, he was elected to a second term as Insurance Commissioner. Mr. Garamendi is currently a candidate for Lieutenant Governor.

Insurance Commissioner Garamendi's commitment to affordable and accessible health care led him to convene a series of meetings at the end of 2004 with leaders and experts in the field to discuss the state of health care in California. In January 2005, he published his conclusions in an extensive report entitled "*Priced Out: Health Care in California*". This document details his vision and recommendations for a universal health care program to fulfill his goal health care for all Californians. *Priced Out* is available online at: www.garamendi.org

Insurance Commissioner Garamendi holds a Bachelors Degree in business from UC Berkeley and a Masters in Business Administration from Harvard Business School. Prior to earning his MBA, the Insurance Commissioner and his wife, Patti, were Peace Corps volunteers in Ethiopia. He is committed to international service and has been an active participant in peace negotiations in Ethiopia, Eritrea and the Congo Civil War.
